SUBJECT: Community Centre Water Leak

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Operational Services

MOTION:

The Town of Sundre Council moves to allocate \$8,000 from the Community Centre Joint/Tenant reserves to cover the cost of fixing the water leak on the main water line on the ceiling at the Community Centre with the work to be done by Diversified Maintenance.

ALTERNATIVE ACTIONS:

The Town of Sundre Council does not move to allocate funds from the Community Centre Joint /Tenant reserves accounts to cover the cost of fixing the water leak on the main water line on the ceiling at the Community Centre.

BACKGROUND:

The main water line comes into the Community Centre building, into the small mechanical room attached to the Conference Room, over the Conference Room, through the upstairs Play School storage room and into the Boiler Room.

Over the last 2-3 years we have started to experience pinhole leaks in the line. The one over the conference room has been repaired multiple times, but one of the leaks in the Boiler Room has become too large to completely patch.

A local plumber was called to assess the problem. The main water line in the Community Centre is an old copper line and the leaks are coming from the joints in the pipes.

DISCUSSION/OPTIONS:

Diversified Maintenance recommended the replacement of the main water line on the Community Centre ceiling. Should one of the welds fracture we could have a major flood. The other tenants in the building will not lose water service when the line will be replaced.

COSTS/SOURCE OF FUNDING:

\$8,000 Community Centre Joint/Tenant Reserve


On behalf of the Minister, I regret to advise that the following project application submitted to the SCF has been declined:
