

**2017 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS
ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE**

Are you Eligible to Vote on October 6 (Advance Vote) or October 16 (Election Day)? When registering to vote you will be asked to confirm the following:

- You have not voted before in this election;
- You are 18 years of age or older;
- You are a Canadian Citizen;
- You have resided in the Province of Alberta for six (6) consecutive months preceding Election Day;
- You are a resident of the Town of Sundre

You will be required to provide Photo Identification as proof of Residency.
Please bring the following with you to the polling station on
October 6 or October 16
