COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT

Are you a business located in Sundre's downtown core looking to revamp your storefront? The Commercial Landscape Improvement Program Grant provides funding for up to 50% of eligible landscape improvements up to a maximum of:

- \$500.00 per commercial property;
- \$1,000.00 for a commercial building with 4 or more storefronts, or large commercial enterprises that are of similar size to that of 4 or more storefronts.

The CLIP Grant is managed and administered by the Economic Development Department under the guidance of the Downtown Area Revitalization Committee. The application deadline has been extended to **August 31st, 2017**.

GREEN (COMPOST) BIN TIPS:

To reduce odors

- Sprinkle small amount of baking soda or powdered laundry detergent (without bleach) at the bottom of the cart and over layers of waste.
- Wait until right before pickup day to clean out the refrigerator.
- Ice is nice. Keep meat or fish scraps in the freezer until collection day.
- When composting animal waste, put the waste in a compostable bag & tie it.
- Store your cart in a shaded or covered area.
- Grass clippings add necessary nitrogen to a compost pile, but be sure to mix with the "brown" materials that add carbon. Both are necessary for quick decomposition and rich compost. Piles made up of just grass clippings will compact, slow down and start to stink.

To keep Green Cart clean

- Rinse your green cart with lemon juice, vinegar or baking soda helps keep bugs out.
- Spray your green cart with cooking oil in the winter to minimize freezing to the cart.

To help keep pests away

- Sprinkle strong smelling biodegradable repellent such as vinegar or detergent (without bleach) on your cart.
- Peppermint oil, cayenne pepper or hot sauce act as anti-gnawing repellents and deter animals from taking interest in your cart.
