### BUSINESS LICENSE FEES

There will be **NO INCREASES** to the Town of Sundre Business License fees for 2018.  
**Home – Based Business License** - No increase, remains at \$65.25  
**Business in Town of Sundre** - No increase, remains at \$108.00  
**Business from out of Town** - No increase, remains at \$161.00

### 2018 UTILITY RATES

Town Council has passed the 2018 Rates and Fees By-law setting a **zero increase** in Utility Rates from 2017.

Town of Sundre Utility Bills will reflect the Alberta Government's Carbon Levy Rate increase from \$1.01/Gigajoule to \$1.517/Gigajoule on natural gas consumption.

The Town of Sundre is required to collect this levy and pass it on to the Province.
