2018 TAX & ASSESSMENT NOTICES HAVE BEEN SENT BY TOWN OF SUNDRE

The Town of Sundre has issued the combined Assessment and Tax Notices with a Notice of Assessment Date of May 18, 2018 as required by section 310 (3) of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26

The assessment roll will be open for inspection or complaint for 60 days at which time the compliant period will close for 2018.

All complaints must be received at the Town Office using the required Complaint Form along with a Complaint Filing fee on or before Tuesday, July 17th, 2018.

DON'T FLUSH TROUBLE

Many items we use on a daily basis cannot go down our toilets or drains. By flushing down the toilet or pouring these materials down any of the drains in your home, you can cause:

- Damage or blockages of your home plumbing, which could lead to basement flooding
- Damage to the Town's sewer pipes located under the streets, which could lead to basement flooding
- Damage to wastewater treatment plants
- Harm to the environment and aquatic habitat in the local streams and rivers

The label might say "flushable" or biodegradable" but some of those items are clogging our sewer lines and damaging pumps and other equipment.

If it isn't sewage or toilet paper don't put it in the toilet.

The following is a list of products that you should not flush or put down your drain:

PRODUCT	WHERE IT SHOULD GO
Wipes/baby wipes (even those that say flushable can cause a problem)	Garbage
Tampons, sanitary pads	Garbage
Medications	Return to Pharmacy
Band-aids, dental floss, cotton swabs and condoms	Garbage
Kitty Litter	Garbage
Hair from brushes	Garbage
Toothpicks	Garbage
Cigarette Butts	Garbage
Vegetables & Fruit scraps	Compost
Fats, oils and grease	Transfer Station
Coffee grounds	Compost
Paper towels, tissue paper	Garbage
