**LAND USE BYLAW AMENDMENT
LEGALIZATION OF NON-MEDICAL CANNABIS AND RETAIL STORES**

It is anticipated that the Federal legislation to legalize the possession, growing and selling of non-medical cannabis and related products will become law by the Fall of 2018. The Province of Alberta has implemented law on the consumption of cannabis with the main focus on the protection of youth and limiting exposure to second-hand smoke.

The Town of Sundre has the ability, through its Land Use Bylaw, to further determine the location of retail cannabis store(s) within its boundary, by establishing minimum distances from schools, health care facilities, municipal and school reserve lands, and other public places like parks, playgrounds, the arena, community centre, library, and day care facilities.
