

COVID-19 Greenwood Campground Rules and Regulations

Regulations shall apply for the opening of the Town of Sundre Greenwood Campground and remain in place until further notice, with updates to be provided and coordinated with AHS guidance at all times.

- Payment accepted by Debit, Mastercard, Visa, and Cash.
- Currently only self-contained RV units will be allowed to register at our campground.
- > Currently no individual tenting will be allowed, RV Units must be self-contained.
- Individuals should not enter the campground if they are experiencing symptoms including cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat that are not related to pre-existing illness or health condition, or are otherwise required to isolate or quaratine. If you aren't feeling well, please stay home.
- Currently Washrooms/Shower House and Cookhouse shelter shall remain closed.
- Sanitize contact surfaces before and after use at Potable Water Fill and Sani-Station. Bringing alcohol-based sanitizer is recommended for hand hygiene when soap and water are not available. You are to provide your own PPE (gloves, masks, etc.) as needed for utilizing the Campground.
- ➤ To meet physical distancing requirements, only members of the same household or cohort family should stay together on a campsite.
- Picnic Tables
 - It is highly recommended to use a table cover.
 - o Table will be cleaned with anti-viral product between overnight guests.
- Follow Physical Distancing at all times, particularly at the gazebo, and playground.
- ➤ Pedestrians (including bicycles) can utilize trails (including roadways) and the gazebo area within the campground. Pedestrians must not linger in the park or attempt to visit any campsites.
- Quiet hours 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
 - o Gates will be locked, vehicle access unavailable. If you need out between these hours please ensure your vehicle is outside of the gates.
- ➤ Keep pets on a leash and cleanup after them at all times. The pet owner is liable for the damages suffered from the pet to any person while anywhere in this campground.
- > Please keep fires within the designated fire-rings at your site. Fire bans enforced.
- Fireworks Prohibited as per Town of Sundre Bylaw 763.
- Keep consumption of alcohol/cannabis within your campsite.
- Cannabis Consumption Prohibited as per Town of Sundre Bylaw 2018-16.
- Check out by 1:00 p.m.

Please practice responsible camping during this time of COVID-19. Maintain a social distance of a least six feet, do not gather in groups and wash your hands frequently.

Failure to adhere to Policies and Public Health Orders will result in the immediate eviction from the campground, with no refund issued.
